EXPECTED OUTCOMES {THE WHY}

- An updated city playground would:
 - o Provide a free, safe place for children to stay active
 - Help develop self-confidence
 - o Improve social skills
 - Fight childhood obesity
 - Be a multi-generational activity, allowing parents, grandparents, and other caregivers with disabilities or limited mobility to participate with their children
 - o Goal is to break ground on new park in 2023

BUDGET {THE HOW}

Estimated program budget:

• Playground Equipment: \$200,000-\$250,000

Professional Installation: \$50,000PIP Surfacing (7,800 sq ft): \$180,000

• Freight/Other charges/Permits: \$10,000-\$30,000

• Removal/Disposal of existing

equipment and surfacing: \$25,000-\$50,000

• Restoration/Landscaping: \$10,000-\$30,000

• Establish maintenance fund: \$75,000

• Extras (shade cloths, benches): \$300,000+

• Extras (bathroom update) \$200,000+

>>>Total Budget: \$1,050,000-\$1,200,000

COMMUNITY STATISTICS

- Jackson County is home to roughly 21,000 individuals
- 4,000 are children under the age of 18
- 2,000 people with a disability under the age of 65
- Currently, there are no all-abilities public parks or playgrounds within 30 miles of our neighborhood.
