NOTICE

CITY OF BLACK RIVER FALLS CURBSIDE RECYCLING

The City of Black River Falls curbside pickup of the recyclable materials listed below will be during the weeks highlighted on the reverse side of this notice. **The recyclables will be picked up on the same day as your regular garbage collection during those weeks.**

IMPORTANT:	Recycling containers must be kept clean or the recyclables will not be taken. If your container is clean and there is something left in it after collection, it means those items are not recyclable and should be disposed of with your garbage.
BRUSH PICKUP WEEKS:	Brush no larger than 6 inches in diameter and no greater than 6 feet in length may be placed behind the curb in a manner to facilitate chipping. Brush must be placed parallel to the edge of the street with butt ends all facing the same direction for easy access for picking up.
FALL LEAF COLLECTION:	Leaf collection will begin the 3rd week in October and end about the 3rd week in November, weather permitting. Leaves in bags will not be picked up. DO NOT RAKE LEAVES INTO THE STREET AS THEY WILL CLOG THE STORM SEWER DRAINS.

All recyclables should be placed separate from garbage along the curb

PREPARE RECYCLABLES AS FOLLOWS:

RECYCLABLES DO NOT NEED TO BE SEPARATED

GLASS:	Bottles and jars only. Rinse clean. Labels may stay on. Remove caps and rings. NO WINDOW GLASS, LIGHT BULBS, PICTURE TUBES, DISHES, ETC.
PLASTIC:	All #1 through #7 containers must be rinsed and decapped (caps are not recyclable). PLEASE FLATTEN MILK JUGS.
CARDBOARD:	BOXES MUST BE FLATTENED OR THEY WILL NOT BE TAKEN. Waxed boxes are not recyclable. All styrofoam packing must be removed. Please cut boxes in 2-foot by 4-foot pieces and bundle or bag. Cardboard beverage cartons can be included with the cardboard.
TIN CANS:	Rinse and remove labels. Both ends must be cut out and cans must be flattened. The cutout ends are recyclable. Cans with rounded bottoms and coffee cans are accepted and should be flattened. Put in paper or clear plastic bags.
AEROSOL & PAINT CANS:	Need to be empty and paint cans need to be dry and clean.
NEWSPAPER:	Bundle with string or twine or place in paper or clear plastic grocery bags. Phone books will be accepted with newspapers.
MAGAZINES:	All magazines are accepted. Please tie in bundles or put in paper or clear plastic bags.
ALUMINUM:	Clean. We can recycle soda cans, pie tins, foil, etc. Put in paper or clear plastic bags.
PAPER & ENVELOPES:	Paper and window envelopes, along with copy and notebook paper, can be recycled.
SHREDDED PAPER:	All shredded paper may be put in clear plastic bags.

The most important rule is that these materials are to be clean. **NO GARBAGE.**
Garbage cans may be used for recycling. They must be **32 gallon or less** and clearly marked 'Recycling'.
